### **AWAS leases one 737-400 to Sriwijaya Air**

Dublin, 4th September 2008

Dublin based lessor, AWAS, has concluded a lease transaction for one Boeing 737-400 to Sriwijaya Air of Indonesia. This is the first aircraft of this type to be operated by Sriwijaya Air and the third AWAS aircraft to be added to their fleet.

The aircraft will be used to open a new domestic route from Soekarno-Hatta International Airport to Pattimura Airport via Hasanudin in Indonesia. It will also serve the Juanda-Changi route.

Mr. Chandra Lie, CEO & President of Sriwijaya Air said "We are pleased to be extending our business partnership with AWAS even further by supplementing capacity with this additional aircraft.
