AWAS leases two Boeing 767-300ER aircraft to TAM Linhas Aereas

AWAS one of the world's largest aircraft lessors, has concluded lease transactions for two Boeing 767-300ER aircraft to TAM Linhas Aereas. MSN 27468 and MSN 27376 are the first of these aircraft types to enter the TAM fleet and they are expected to see some regional service within South America during the high Summer season before entering into a new service from Brazil to the US.

"AWAS is delighted to be TAM's preferred choice of lessor as they introduce the 767-300ER into their fleet but also as these aircraft will enhance TAM's network by enabling them to offer an important nonstop service between Rio de Janeiro and Miami," said Walter Valarezo, Senior Vice President, Sales at AWAS.
